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Cantho University would like to announce the new International MSc Program

1. Enrollment capacity: 16

2. Application requirements

A person of Laos, Cambodia and Vietnam citizenship fulfilling one of the following conditions:

(1) a Bachelor of degree in Animal Sciences/Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Medicine/Agricultural Forestry/ Aquaculture / Agriculture.

(2) a certificate in English

English language test: (4.5 in academic IELTS test/ 450 TOFFL test).

(3) The Vietnamese Students have to pass the Animal Physiology and Statistics courses of entrance of the MSc examination at Can tho University.

3. Required documents for application

(1) Application form

(2) English certificate of (International) IELTS and B.Sc. Degree

All required documents must be submitted by post before the deadline of the 30th June, 2010 to Cantho University, 3/2 street, Cantho City, Vietnam

4. Total period of time for the course:

18 months (54 credits = 39 credits for courses + 15 credits for research).

5. Finance

The total cost of a Laos/Cambodian student is 11,500 USD. The cost for a Vietnamese student is similar to that of the existing local MSc course at Cantho University. The Vietnamese student has to have a private Laptop computer for his/her studying. However, he or she will be funded 4,000 USD for experiments of the MSc thesis from MEKARN Project.

6. Responsibilities :
